

ESTIMATED COST OF ATTENDANCE IN U.S. DOLLARS FOR INTERNATIONAL (F1) ELTI STUDENTS

The amounts shown below are the estimated costs that international (F1) ELTI students may expect to pay for two academic terms. The length of time to complete two academic terms ranges from seven - nine months.

Note that Fall, Spring, and Summer are all separate semesters. In addition to the cost of tuition and fees which are required by the ELTI and the University, estimated costs are also provided for room and board (food), books, supplies, health insurance, and other personal and miscellaneous expenses.

International (F1) ELTI Estimated Cost of Attendance for Two Academic Terms	
Required Tuition and Fees	\$12,500 USD
Room and Board (average cost of housing and meals)	\$16,000 USD
Health Insurance (health insurance is required for students)	\$3000 USD
Indirect Costs (books/supplies: \$1000; personal expenses: \$3000; miscellaneous: \$2000)	\$6000 USD
TOTAL	\$37,500

IMPORTANT: If you plan to bring your spouse and/or any dependent children with you, your estimated costs will change. The U.S. government defines F-2 dependents as a spouse (husband or wife) and/or any unmarried minor children under 21 years of age.

You should add \$6000 USD to the above total for your husband or wife if you bring them with you.

You should add \$3600 for each unmarried minor child under the age of 21 that you bring with you.

For example, if you plan to bring your spouse and one child with you, your bank statement should demonstrate that you have at least \$47,100 USD available.

All bank statements should be translated into English and have the current balance clearly marked as converted into US dollars. Your bank should be able to do this for you. Bank statements older than six months will not be accepted. If your bank statement is not in your name, you will need to submit a sponsor form.
